

Il graduates of various schools must ultimately decide what to do after graduation. There are basically two options, you can go full-time or start your own business. The choice depends on many external factors, but also on personal preferences, predispositions and skills. The decision to take up employment is one of the most important life decisions.

A full-time job usually offers a sense of security and work comfort, but it can also force you to live under the pressure of your superiors and participate in the corporate rat race. Smaller companies can offer a wider scope and the opportunity to gain richer work experience, but sometimes at the cost of lower pay and a significant workload. Starting your own business can be an interesting alternative to a full-time job, but sometimes it becomes an absolute necessity.

To launch a company and stabilize it on the market, you need much more than narrow specialist knowledge in a specific field obtained during your studies. Above all, managerial competencies are needed, i.e. knowledge of the rules of market functioning and knowledge of the principles of creating and developing business activity. You cannot build a company by improvising by feel. You need a clear vision of goals, knowledge of the industry environment and perseverance.

The training is addressed to graduates of various universities who, by nature, do not yet have experience related to the realities of the labor market or the competences needed to run a business. Its purpose is to facilitate making decisions regarding employment and career development.
